With over 220 participants from 27 countries, the ICPO Forum provided a unique opportunity to explore the latest developments aimed at scaling global patient access to theranostics.

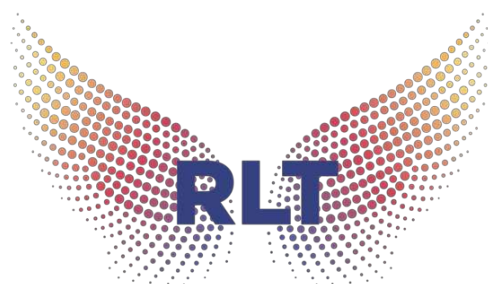
